Institutional Academic Development

2017-18 has witnessed massive international and national academic activities for the College. The main initiative came from the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) spearheaded by its coordinator Dr. Sweta Guha.

The IQAC sponsored workshop has been organized on November 9, 2017 with Dr. Kanika Chatterjee, former IQAC coordinator of Calcutta University and Dr. Shampa Dattagupta, Assistant Director of

Public Instruction as main speakers.

Department of Psychology has organized a pioneering workshop on *Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)* in collaboration with UG Board of Studies, Calcutta University. December 06, 2017. Prof. Nilanjana Sanyal and Prof Jayanti Basu from the University of Calcutta took part in it.

Bengali Department organized an International Seminar December 13, 2017 with eminent litterateur and women's rights



activist Sm. Selina Hossain as the keynote speaker. Dr. Mummun Gangopadhyay of Rabindra Bharati University was the Chief Guest. Dr. Jyotsna Chattopadhyay and Dr. Durba Roychowdhury of Rabindra Bharati and Dr. Suvankar Roy of Ramkrishna Mission Vidyamandir, Belur and Sm Kana Basu Misra, eminent writer were also present.

Department of History organized an International Conference on *Reappraising the Partition of India*, December 15 and 16, 2017 with Dr. Joint Convener: KarabiMitra & Sri. Sixty three papers of the Conference were selected for publication in three special issues of the journal IJESM with Dr Papiya Ghosh and Dr. Rupak Bhattacharyya, Dr. Bidyadhar Mandal, Dr. Nandita Palit and Dr. Samiran Banerjee as editors.

Department of Economics has organized a National conference on February 17-18, 2018 with Bengal Economic Association. The theme was *Economic Theory and Development Economics*. Prof. Aloknanda Patel was the keynote speaker. Prof. Abhirup

Rupkatha Mukherjee.

Department of Political Science has organized a National Conference on *Secularism: Current Trends* on March 16 and 17, 2018. Dr. Sobhanlal DattaGupta, Surendranath Banerjee Professor of Calcutta University was the Chairperson and Dr. Debi Chatterjee, Emeritus Professor of Jadavpur



University and Editor of the Dalit Studies, Sage Publications delivered the keynote address. Prof. Parthapratim Basu, Jadavpur University, Prof.Sanjay Mukherjee, Retired Professor of Jadavpur, Dr. Saumyajit Ray of Jawaharlal Nehru University and Dr. Maidul Islam of Centre for Social Science Studies were the speakers of the conference. Seventy seven papers from different academicians were presented in the two days. On the second day there was a students' Intercollege competition Elocution Competition on the ideas of secularism with the caption 'Secularism to Me'. Represenatives from thirteen institutes took part. Sourav Chakraborty of RamKrishna Mission Vidyamandir, Belur Math, Ahardeep Mukherjee of Rabindra Bharati University and Soumyadeep Mitra, RamKrishna Mission Residential College, Narendrapur emerged as the first three winners and they were rewarded with cash awards and other gifts. Sm.Sarbani Guha Ghosal and Sm Ranjana Sarkar (Ghosh) were the joint conveners of the programme.

UG –PG Interface among the students and teachers were held on May 10, 2018. This is definitely a good initiative of the college

with the intention to promote and popularize the Post Graduate Programmes of the institute. Geography, Sanskrit, Philosophy, Bengali and Commerce took part in it.

Workshop on CBCS was organized on May 11, 2018 to introduce the teaching and non-teaching staff members with the newly introduced system. Sri. Debasis Biswas, Secretary of the University of Calcutta and Dr. Swapan Kumar Pan, Principal, Guskara Mahavidyalaya, Burdwan University were the main speakers on the occasion.

Infrastructural Development

Two new rooms are constructed in the roof of the main building with financial assistance from the MP-LAD scheme offered generously by the local MP Sri Prasoon Banerjee. Biometric attendance system for the teaching and non-teaching staff has been introduced. Installation of solar panel in the college has reduced the electricity bill of the college to a considerable extent. The online admission system is running successfully in accordance with the norms set up by the Higher Education Department of West Bengal. Process for acquiring on-line feedback system is also on and some departments have already started it in this session. The Botany department is continuing the process of Green-audit to make the college campus environment friendly. A water-cooler with Lions Club of Howrah was inaugurated by the President of College Governing Body, Sri. Arup Roy to cater the needs for safe drinking water in the campus. An inspection team of the Higher Education Department visited the college on January 25, 2018. The college has received the sanction of RUSA (Rashtriya Ucchatara Shiksha Avijan), a centrally sponsored grant scheme of the Govt. of India for the college. Accordingly the Detail Project Report (DPR) has been submitted to the higher education department and very soon works in this

direction will commence. A second campus of the college is also on the cards in this regard. The College has taken the challenge to cope up with the newly introduced CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) following the guidelines of the University of Calcutta along with the semester pattern of education. Almost total overhauling of the pattern of teaching, learning and examination system has been started for it with active cooperation of the teaching and non-teaching staff members. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been signed with the Howrah Municipal Corporation (HMC) regarding the regular utilization of their Sports Complex. Another Solar panel is slated to be launched soon in collaboration with the Howrah Improvement Trust (HIT). In continuation with its modernization drive the College has applied for the GST registration and very soon also has obtained its GST identification number. The accounts department staff and some teaching members also took training in this regard. For maintaining transparency in the administration we have adopted the path of E-Tendering and also have registered for it with the WBNIC. This e-Procurement System enables the Tenderers to download the Tender Schedule free of cost and then submit the bids online through the Government maintained portal.















